First study in Canada to look at a parasite that may play a role in Equine Abortions

Neospora caninum is a major cause of abortion in cattle, and this parasite may be an unrecognized cause of abortion in mares.

Ontario study could help defend horses from tick-borne disease

Dr. Luis Arroyo and his team at OVC set out to identify the prevalence of B. burgdorferi and A. phagocytophilum seropositivity in Ontario horses and identify geographic risk factors.

Veterinary clinics all across Ontario participated, sending in blood serum samples along with a questionnaire which evaluated demographics, clinical history and farm management of each horse in the study. Half of horse owners surveyed reported checking for ticks and 15% of them report finding ticks.
