EQUINE GUELPH HOSTING EQUINE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND LARGE ANIMAL RESCUE TRAINING



Equine Guelph will be hosting a one day equine emergency workshop for horse owners and a three day large animal rescue training course for first responders this fall with the world renowned leader in this field: Dr. Rebecca Gimenez (TLAER Inc.)

September 18 - **Emergency Preparedness for Horse Owners** one-day workshop will provide horse owners valuable skills to help prevent emergency situations from occurring on their property or while travelling with their trailer. Horse owners will also learn the best course of action to take if an emergency does happen and will be given an overview of techniques involved in large animal rescue. This workshop will take place at the University of Guelph and is eligible for Equine Canada coach updating credits. Cost: \$125

September 19, 20 and 21 - **Large Animal Rescue for First Responders** operational-level training will be offered for the first time in Ontario. This training will give emergency response professionals the knowledge and skills to effectively deal with incidents involving large animals.

This is especially timely, with the upcoming Pan-Am Games set to bring a high number of valuable horses and trailers to roadways and venues around southern Ontario.

This training will take place at the Adjala-Tosorontio Fire Department, (near Orangeville) in the heart of horse country, a partner on this training initiative. Cost: \$475 hands-on, \$200 audit

PLAN A HEAD

Helmet head may be unflattering but is it worth risking vegetable brain? No matter what the riding discipline, wearing a helmet is one of the best ways to plan ahead to minimize the chance of a brain injury. Safety starts before a foot even goes into the stirrup as 20% of accidents which result in head injury happen while the person is on the ground. It is not uncommon for an incident to occur while mounting and no discipline is without risk when it comes to falling off.



For correct fit - the peak should be parallel to the ground and buckles done up snug.

Everyone hits the dirt at some point and the purchase of a correctly fitted riding helmet, that carries a safety rating, is a wise investment. Play safe and put your head in a helmet when working around horses.


