# **REASEARCH SURVEY**

Can you tell what that neigh means?

A research study at University of Guelph is setting out to determine whether humans can make accurate distinctions between horse vocalizations produced in both positive (eg. horses greeting each other) and negative (eg. horse separated from its companions) contexts.

Participation in this study is on the voluntary basis. To participate, you must be 18 years of age or older, answer a few questions about yourself, listen to 32 short audio clips and decide whether
